

## **Planning Review & Adjustment Committee (PRAC) Member Vacancies**

The Board of Regional Service Commission 11 is anticipating vacancies on the Planning Review and Adjustment Committee in January 2019 and is currently accepting expressions of interest to serve on that committee.

The Planning Review and Adjustment Committee (PRAC) is appointed by the Regional Service Commission to carry out advisory and decision-making functions as specified under the provincial Community Planning Act.

These responsibilities include, but are not limited to, decisions on variances to zoning provisions and the location of public streets or provision of other suitable access in a proposed plan of subdivision, and advice to either the Municipal Council or the Minister of Environment and Local Government as the case may be, on rezoning applications under their consideration.

The Planning Review and Adjustment Committee meet monthly to hear applications for matters on land use planning.

Committee members must be eligible to vote under the Local Governance Act and be a resident in a community which gets its land use planning services from the Commission.

In evaluating candidates for appointment to PRAC the Board shall consider their knowledge of the land development trends, practices and issues; local government functions and experience on volunteer-based committees. In addition the Board shall seek a diversity of interests and backgrounds.
